Thierry Mayer (Sciences Po Paris) and Christina Gathmann (LISER) will give the keynote lectures.

Accommodation will be provided to accepted speakers. PhD and Postdoc scholars are encouraged to apply. A travel grant will be awarded to two junior researchers.
